Our guest speakers, **Suzanne Brown Walsh, J.D.**, and **Stuart G. Warner, Esq.**, will give a multidisciplinary presentation on the *Real Life Operation of Living Wills* that we are certain will prove most informative to us all.

**Suzanne Brown Walsh** joined Cummings & Lockwood's Private Clients Group in 2001 and is a Principal in the firm's West Hartford office. She specializes in estate planning, particularly for families of children with special needs, and elder law and estate and trust administration. Suzanne has spoken before countless groups and has authored several articles on estate planning and taxation. She is a member of the Connecticut and Massachusetts Bars and holds a B.S. degree from Boston University and a J.D. from Suffolk University Law School.

Suzanne was appointed by Governor Rell in 2005 to serve as one of Connecticut's eight Commissioners on Uniform Laws. As such, she represents the state as a member of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, a 113 year old organization which promotes statutory uniformity. In addition, Suzanne is a former Chair of the Connecticut Bar Association's Elder Law Section, currently serves as Vice Chair of the Estates and Probate Section, is on the latter's Steering Committee and co-Chairs its Uniform Laws Subcommittee. For the past five years, Suzanne has led the group studying and drafting the Connecticut Uniform Trust Code, which, when enacted, will be the first comprehensive codification of the law of trusts in Connecticut. She is a Fellow of the American College of Trusts and Estates Counsel (ACTEC). She has also served on the Board of Directors of several community organizations, including PLAN of Connecticut, Inc., a local, nonprofit group providing low cost trust services to the families of the disabled. Before it was disbanded, Suzanne served for years on the Connecticut Law Revision Commission's Probate Advisory Committee.

Since 1991, **Stuart G. Warner** has worked as Assistant Counsel at Yale-New Haven Hospital, where she serves as a member of the Hospital's Bioethics Committee, often consulting on end-of-life issues. Between 1987 and 1991, she was with Cummings & Lockwood as a member of the Health Law group. Stuart is a graduate of Amherst College and Boston University School of Law, and following graduation, she clerked for the Honorable Boyce F. Martin, Jr. of the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals.
