We are pleased to announce that Family Law expert **Peter M. Bryniczka, Esq., Partner, Schoonmaker, George & Blomberg, P.C.,** will be our guest speaker at our December 7th dinner meeting at **Innis Arden Golf Club** in Old Greenwich. As this is our year-end holiday gathering, **the format of this meeting will be our usual dinner program,** with cocktails (cash bar) beginning at 5:45 p.m., followed by dinner promptly at 6:30 p.m., speaker at 7:30 p.m., and we anticipate an end to the meeting between 8:30 p.m. and 8:45 p.m.

This presentation will provide a thorough understanding of how various factors are considered when working with divorcing couples. Also discussed will be the application of that definition to a divorce litigant's interest in a trust and whether it is property to be divided on divorce, when is it property and why, and when is it not property and why not.

While in law school, Attorney Bryniczka was an Associate Editor of the Connecticut Journal of International Law and cofounder of the UCONN Law Ice Hockey Team. He was admitted to practice in Connecticut in November 2004 and is a member of the Fairfield County Bar Association, the Connecticut Bar Association, and the American Bar Association and the Family Law sections of these Bar Associations.
